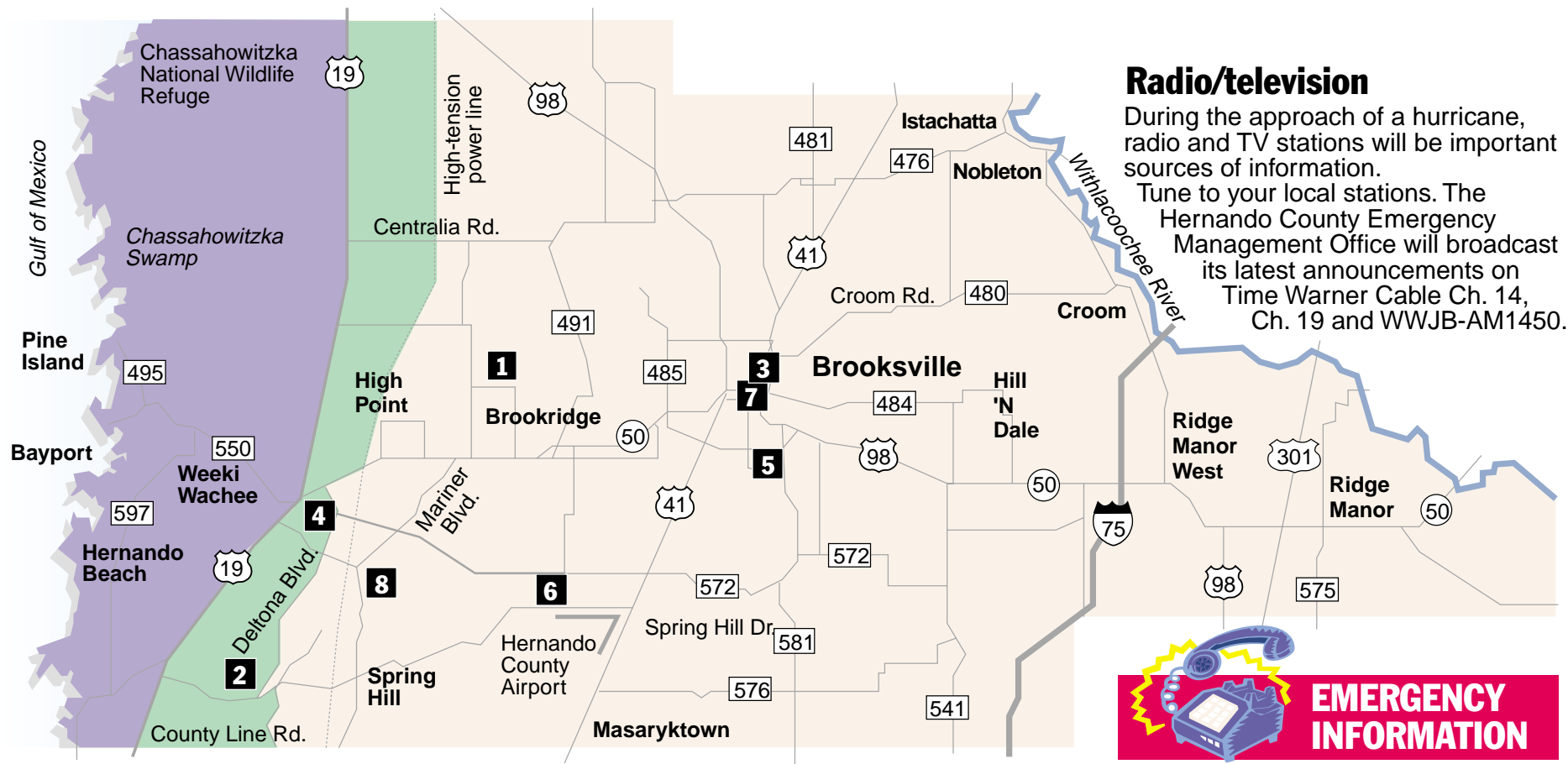


Hernando evacuation zones



Radio/television

During the approach of a hurricane, radio and TV stations will be important sources of information. Tune to your local stations. The Hernando County Emergency Management Office will broadcast its latest announcements on Time Warner Cable Ch. 14, Ch. 19 and WWJB-AM1450.

Evacuation A

- All who live west of U.S. 19.
- All mobile home residents.

Evacuation B

- All who live west of Waterfall Drive, Deltona Boulevard and high-tension power lines.
- All mobile home residents.
- Residents of areas near the Withlacoochee River and other flood-prone, low-lying sections.
